What's the Cost?

£80 for adults and £60 for children (under 18).

Who Can Join?

Archery is for everyone! If you're 10 or older, you're in! All you need is the curiosity to try something new. If you're under 18, make sure to bring along a parent, guardian, or responsible adult (they don't have to shoot, but we'd love for them to join in – after all, archery is a fun family activity!). If you have any medical conditions, just let us know ahead of time so we can make sure the course is tailored to your needs. Don't worry – we'll keep it all confidential!

When and Where?

The course takes place over four consecutive Saturdays, each session lasting 2½ hour (starting at 10 AM). What Will You Learn?

Who's Doing the Teaching?

Our expert coaches, all trained and qualified by Archery GB (the official governing body of archery), will guide you through the course with their skills and experience. They follow the Archery GB coaching model, have up-to-date DBS checks, and are all safeguarding trained – so you're in safe, knowledgeable hands!

What About Equipment?

No need to worry about buying your own equipment! We've got you covered with bows, arrows, and all the safety equipment you'll need.

What to Bring?

We'll be shooting outdoors, so dress for the weather! On sunny days, bring sunscreen, a hat, and a bottle of water. Wear comfortable, close-fitting clothes (no loose sleeves, please!) and flat-soled shoes (no sandals for safety). If you have long hair, tie it back, and leave the jewellery at home.

What's Next?

After you've completed the course, you'll get your *Archery Certificate* confirming your ability to shoot safely with confidence. And if you're ready to keep shooting, you can join our club where you will get year-round shooting, ongoing coaching support, and enjoy free access to club equipment.
